Youth Ministry at Westminster focuses on the youth of the church in helping them grow in their relationship with God and with each other. Our youth are led in many ways by adults who are visible examples of God's love. Youth are nurtured through faith formation, Westminster Youth Fellowship inc (WYFi), confirmation, worship, outreach activities, mission trips, Montreat conferences, play, and fellowship. WYfi

(Westminster Youth Fellowship inc)

Our WYFi Youth group is an opportunity to build intentional community with each other, pray, learn and grapple with questions about faith and how God is present in our lives.

How do I join?

The beauty of all youth programming at Westminster is that all you must do is show up. There is not a team to "try out" for or make, no membership required, and it is open to all.

What happens on Sunday evenings?

We meet most Sunday evenings during the school year from 5:30 – 7:30. We start the evening with games and team building exercises which is followed by dinner. The evening is finished out by learning Biblical practices of how to live out our faith using the PCSUA curriculum, Follow Me: Biblical Practices for Faithful Living.

So, all this happens EVERY Sunday night?

Almost!

On the first Sunday of each month we have partnered with eight other Presbyterian churches in the area and have formed a group called Youth Collective (YOCO for short). YOCO is about bringing youth together to grow deeper roots of faith and community.

On the first Sunday of every month we will gather at a different church location (locations and addresses will be in Westminster's weekly E=- for games, a meal, and a short worship time together. The churches participating in YOCO are: Alamance Presbyterian, Community in Christ Presbyterian, Fellowship Presbyterian, First Presbyterian, Guilford Park Presbyterian, Jamestown Presbyterian, St. James Presbyterian, and Westminster Presbyterian.

Westminster will host YOCO, Oct., 1, 2023 from 5:30 – 7:30pm.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is a season of searching and discovery for 9th graders to deepen their journey of faith. This year is designed to challenge our youth to think theologically and to ask deep questions about the Bible and their faith. We want youth to claim their faith as their own and encourage them to think about what they believe and why they believe it. We want them to come away from this experience with the desire to continue digging into what it means to be a child of God and how that effects our lives and the lives of those we are in community, as well as, what it means to live out our faith outside the wall of the church.

FAITH FORMATION

All youth grades 6th—12th gather in room 100 on Sunday mornings from 10—10:50am for refreshments and announcements and will then be dismissed to their respective rooms. Middle school youth will go to room 104, high school youth will go to room 102, and our confirmation class will stay in room 100.

Our format for Sunday mornings is laid back and designed to be easy for our youth to engage. We touch base using what we call Joy, Junk, and Jesus. This encourages youth to share a joy, something good that happened during the previous week, a junk, something not so great, and a Jesus moment, a point where they saw Jesus at work in the world. We then use d365 which is a daily devotion written for youth. The devotion follows a five-step format — *Pause, Listen, Think, Pray, Go.*

The *Pause* step remains the same all week and is designed as a centering tool.

The *Listen* step is the scripture passage for the day, using the Common English Bible translation.

The *Think* step is the devotional thought by the week's writer. The *Pray* step is the start of a prayer that can be expand into our own conversation with God.

The Go step is a call to action

The devotions are written by ministers, professors, students, teachers, missionaries, denominational leaders, and others who work with and care for students. Typically, an author writes on a single theme for one week. In these devotions, we read about honest struggles and questions, all in the context of real faith. As we read the thoughts of the writers, we discuss our own responses to the scripture for the day. We let the writer's words serve as background for our own conversation with God and each other.

Our high school graduates take a culminating trip together that is funded by our Youth Endowment fund. This is a time to reflect on our time in community together and to celebrate what's next in life for them.

Our middle school and high school youth rotate between mission trips and conferences each summer. This year, 2024, our high school youth will have the opportunity to serve on a mission trip to NYC and the middle school youth will have the opportunity to attend the Montreat youth conference in Maryville, TN.

Next summer, 2025, our middle school youth will serve on a mission trip to CROSS Mission in Charlotte, NC and the high school youth will attend the Montreat High School Conference in Black Mountain. These trips alternate each year until they graduate.

The Montreat youth conferences affirm our youth in their calling to not only be the church of today but the church of tomorrow. Through daily worship, keynote, recreation, and small groups, Montreat conferences help youth explore their spiritual, intentional relationship with God, themselves, and other youth

Westminster's youth mission trips are to encourage our youth to step outside of themselves, to serve others, and open ourselves to the needs of others in our world. Each of our trips is designed to serve at 2 different volunteer sights each day and to experience being the hands and feet of Christ. At then end of each day we debrief and have a time to be together in Christian community and have a little fun.
