2025 Western NC Helene Rebuilding Mission Trips

We are ready to roll up our sleeves and get to work in Western NC partnering with the nonprofit organization **All Hands & Hope** (AHAH) for two mission trips. The type of work will vary from cleanup to rebuilding. No experience necessary.

Location: Both work trips will be based just outside of Asheville.

Accommodations: The group will be staying in cabins just outside of Asheville with communal rooms with bunkbeds.

Meals: Typically meals will be make-your-own breakfast and lunch, with supplies provided (i.e. oats, eggs, lunch meat, bread, etc. and a warm dinner typically prepared by staff and volunteers, or sometimes provided by community members. We will go out to dinner one night as a group.

What to bring: Packing list will be sent out closer to the trip.

Itinerary: Tuesday: Travel Day, Wed-Friday: Work Days, Saturday: Travel Day

Transportation: Church van / personal vehicles

What to pack: Packing list will be sent closer to the trip.

Age Requirement: 18 years & up

Cost / Person: \$125 - Includes meals (not including 1 dinner out), lodging accommodations, and transportation costs. Open until all 10 slots are filled.
