Fuller Center Disaster Rebuilders

BLACK MOUNTAIN, NC August 3-8

Fuller Center Disaster ReBuilders is a 501(c)(3) Christian organization dedicated to serving the victims of major disasters in the United States. Organized in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina in 2005, they have supported rebuilding in most major hurricane disaster areas since then. They serve uninsured, low-income homeowners using volunteer labor to make rebuilding effort more affordable. They are financed from donations and grants.

When: August 3-8

Location: Black Mountain, NC

Accommodations: We will be housed at Cragmont Assembly Camp & Retreat in Black Mountain. The bunkhouses on campus are divided into 2 large rooms. There are separate male and female bathrooms in the bunk house with multiple toilets and showers. The campus has a full kitchen and dining area, as well as a fantastic view of the mountains.

Meals: Meals are provided with the exception of Wednesday dinner giving the group an opportunity to eat out to support the local economy.

Itinerary: We will plan to depart on Sunday, August 3 around 1:00 pm. Friday, August 8 is yet to be determined depending if we decide to work the morning before departing for home. As for workdays, breakfast is between 6:30-7:30 am. Leave for worksite at 7:45 am. Lunch at worksite 12:00 pm. Depart our worksite around 4:00 pm. Dinner at 6 pm and free evening after that.

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Transportation: We will determine this closer to the trip. We will most likely take the church van and a few personal vehicles.

What to pack: Specific packing list will be sent closer to the trip. Keep in mind you'll want to bring sheets/blanket or sleeping bag for twin bunk and a pillow.

Type of work: Type of work we will be doing could either be cleaning out or rehabbing (insulation, drywalling, floors and doors, painting, etc.) homes. No experience necessary.

Age Requirement: You must be at least 16 years old to volunteer with Fuller Center Disaster Rebuilders. Volunteers under 18 years old are permitted to work on the construction site but must be supervised by a parent or legal guardian at all times. You must also complete their "Minor Permission Consent form."

Cost / Person: \$125 / person - Includes meals (not including 1 dinner out), lodging accommodations, and transportation costs.

Deadline to sign up: Sunday, June 1. We have 10 slots reserved. Once filled, we may not be able to add additional slots.
