



things that we can do right now to respond to God's call in our place, for our time.




In concert with our Lenten theme, we'll be

FRESH MOBILE MARKET

Saturday, February 17 from 9:45 - 11:30 am Peck Elementary School

Out of the Garden Project's Fresh Mobile Markets program is a mobile food pantry service available currently at 20+ locations in Guilford County every month. Westminster provides volunteers on the 3rd Saturday morning of each month located at Peck Elementary, 1601 W. Florida St. Around 10 people are required each month, and the minimum age is 13. Ages 13 - 16 must be with a parent or responsible adult. OOTGP Fresh Mobile Markets take place at high need GCS schools and Guilford County food deserts. WPC's sponsored site serves 90+ families, and each family receives between 50 – 70 pounds of food. Each Fresh Mobile Market provides 60+ pounds of fresh

produce, meat, and bread per qualifying family. Scan the QR code to sign up or visit westpreschurch.org/serve
